<b>Introduction</b>			
<p>The REACT project hosted a significant event in Turin on the 7th of September of 2023 where project partners presented their respective local roadmaps for the implementation of policy recommendations that emerged from the project. The event aimed to showcase the collaborative efforts of the project partners and their commitment to translating research findings into actionable policies at the local level.</p>			
<b>Agenda</b>			
<p>The event started with encouraging remarks from Carlotta Salerno, Councillor for Suburbs and Urban Regeneration Projects, Educational and Youth Policies, and Roberto Vito Grieco, Youth Policy Area Manager, highlighting the mental well-being of our young population as a top priority and the heartening commitment of REACT partners to address this critical issue. The workshop proceeded with two presentations from local stakeholders showing the experiences of ASL Turin's counselling services targeting youth in the COVID and post-COVID period. A report of activity of the Adolescent Listening Centers and the presentation of the research "Youth and pandemic. The Italian reality" by the PIN, service of prevention and information about drugs and alcohol abuse.</p> <p>After a brief presentation about the objectives and outcomes of the project so far, the rest of the workshop was dedicated to the local roadmaps where each project partner presented their unique approach to implementing the project's policy recommendations. After a Q&amp;A session following each presentation, a panel discussion, moderated by an expert in the field, provided the opportunity for exploring challenges, opportunities, and lessons learned from developing local roadmaps.</p> <p>The 8<sup>th</sup> of September, partners had the opportunity to visit the InformaGiovani Torino service in Via Garibaldi, 25, 10121, Turin and the 'Aria/Spazi Reali' service in Corso San Maurizio 4, 10124, Torino to keep learning about Turin's experiences in supporting the mental health care of its young people with services about job orientation, psychological counselling and recreational activities.</p>			
<b>Key Highlights</b>			
<p>The presentations included innovative strategies for engaging local stakeholders, including community members, government officials, and NGOs. Partners showcased their commitment to making a tangible impact on their respective communities and regions.</p> <p>The panel discussion provided a platform for in-depth discussions on the challenges and opportunities of implementing policy recommendations at the local level. Attendees appreciated the practical insights shared by the project partners and expressed interest in future collaborations. After this, Turin presented the Memorandum of Understanding.</p>			
<b>Next Steps</b>			
<p>Future events and knowledge-sharing sessions will be organized to foster collaboration and exchange of best practices among partners. The CERV program's event was a significant step toward translating research findings into meaningful policy changes at the local level. It showcased the dedication of project partners and their commitment to improving the well-being of their communities through evidence-based policy implementation.</p>
